Ideas for Action

FACT:

All major religions support donation.

FOR EMPLOYEES

- Send a paper, electronic or voice mail message promoting donation from the President/CEO to each employee.
- Distribute registry forms and educational materials to employees.
- Add a Donate Life message to employee pay stubs or include Donate Life paycheck stuffers.
- Display registry forms and donation-related materials in high traffic areas, such as the lobby, cafeteria and break rooms.
- Add a link to the LifeGift or Donate Life Texas website on your website for more information.
- Host an on-site educational presentation for all employees.
- Add a link to the LifeGift or Donate Life Texas website on the company intranet or in-house e-mail system.
- Run a web banner or flash e-mail presentation on your in-house e-mail system.
- Send a personalized e-postcard to employees from your President/CEO.
- Include an article about donation in your company newsletter. Feature stories about area recipients or donor families.
- Post the Workplace Partnership for Life poster and educational material on company bulletin boards.
- Identify employees within your organization whose lives have been touched by donation and transplantation.
- Highlight personal stories in newsletters or e-mail to promote interest in your workplace.

- Enter a corporate team in the Second Chance Run held in Fort Worth in the Spring.
- Implement a leave policy for employees who donate an organ.
- Create Donate Life Stickers for ID badges and make available to employees who wish to show their support.

FOR CLIENTS AND/OR CUSTOMERS

- Provide a link to LifeGift on your company website.
- Include an electronic banner ad on your company website.
- Print a Donate Life Texas message on sales receipts.
- Record a Donate Life statement for your on-hold phone message.
- Include a lifesaving message about donation on client/customer billing statements.
- Promote your involvement in the Workplace Partnership for Life in annual reports and newsletters.
- Provide Donate Life Texas information to all clients/customers.
- Include the Donate Life Texas website in your correspondence.

FOR BUSINESSES/ORGANIZATIONS

- Sponsor a LifeGift event such as the Vital Volunteers banquet or the Candle Lighting Ceremony.
- Send an electronic registration form and informational brochure to your employees.
