#### Reimbursement for donor preparation and embalming

According to state and federal legislation, donor families cannot be incentivized for the gift of donation. This includes reimbursement for additional funeral expenses due to donation. LifeGift does offer reimbursement for donation-related expenses incurred by the funeral home.

To receive reimbursement for donation related reconstruction, please email an invoice to <u>lginvoices@lifegift.org</u>. Invoices should include the following:

- Donor's name
- LifeGift's identification number
- Date of donation

- Expenses pertaining to the type of arrangements and gifts donated
- Include a W-9 form if one has not been previously provided to LifeGift

## LifeGift offers the following funeral home reimbursement

Donors who have a viewing followed by cremation or burial:

□ All donation \$100

#### OR

Donors who have been embalmed for services (donated gifts/services identified by LifeGift below):

- Heart only (with associated vessels) \$75
- Bone with associated tissues of legs and arms \$200
- □ Vascular tissue of legs only (not in conjunction with bone) \$50
- □ Supplies \$50
- After-hours access as requested by LifeGift \$100

- Partial depth skin \$50
- Full depth skin \$150
- □ Spine \$100
